

Performance Analyst - Netball Netherlands National Team

Overview:

As Netball Netherlands launches its first-ever national team, we're looking for a Performance Analyst to help shape performance strategy through insightful data collection, analysis, and reporting. This is a unique opportunity to work at the foundation level of high-performance netball in a developing nation, supporting coaches and athletes to make data-informed decisions that enhance player development and team performance.

The Performance Analyst will primarily work remotely, with a focus on supporting the coaching team through video analysis, data collection, and performance insights. Where possible, the analyst can attend monthly in-person training sessions, held as single full-day sessions on weekends (typically Saturday or Sunday) in various cities across the Netherlands. Travel will be required for matches, tournaments, or similar events throughout the season.

Please note: This is currently a volunteer role as we build the foundation of netball in the Netherlands. The Sports Data Analyst will report to the Head Coach

Key Responsibilities:

- Collect and analyse player and team performance data from training sessions and match play.
- Create reports and visualisations to support coaching decisions and tactical planning.
- Track and monitor athlete metrics such as fitness, workload, and skill execution.
- Contribute to player selection insights through data-informed assessments.
- Support the coaching team in identifying performance trends and areas for improvement.
- Manage and update a centralised database of performance metrics
- Collaborate with coaches to integrate analytics into the broader athlete development strategy.

Requirements:

• Background in sports science, performance analysis, data analytics, or a related field.



- Passion for sport, and ideally with a knowledge of netball, both in terms of standard metric definitions, and game strategies
- Experience working with performance analysis tools and/or spreadsheet-based analytics
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills with attention to detail.
- Ability to communicate data in a clear, useful way for coaches and players.
- Comfortable working remotely and attending monthly in-person sessions as required.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a collaborative coaching team.
