We heard your feedback

The Bond is appreciated for its **dedication and league management**, but clubs are asking for a **more professionalized**, **structured**, **and communicative organization** — one that supports clubs strategically (finance, visibility, governance) as much as operationally (league and umpiring).

What's Working Well

- Clubs report a generally positive experience with the Bond and growing awareness of its mission and members
- Strong league management and umpire development — including accessible online workshops (thanks, Ashlee!)
- Inclusive financial model that supports smaller clubs

What's Missing

- Greater clarity on what the Bond does (especially for newer clubs) and who its members are
- Clearer, more consistent communication and transparency with a single source of information about meetings, decisions, procedures, finances, administrative information etc
- Broader support beyond league operations

- 2. Contacting new clubs & getting them up to speed

- 2. Provide more chances for members to play with people from other clubs.

Branding, Social Media & Comms

- 1. Strengthen the Bond's visibility and reputation ensuring members recognize its role, feel its presence at club level, and value its contributions
- 2. Improve communication flows between the Bond and clubs.
- 3. Enhance brand awareness and social media presence.

- 1. Investigate sustainable sources of long-term funding for NN Bond

Netball Netherlands League

- 1. Run a successful league season including new finals structure & friendly (lower level) league competition
- 2. Expand the league towards 9/10 teams competing
- 3. Smooth and frequent communication between league team and bond, and also league team/bond with clubs.

Umpiring

- 1. **Standardize Accreditation:** Lay the foundations for Netherlands-based accreditation to the C Award level, including facilitation of the required Europe Netball course, and consolidate existing umpire accreditations.
- 2. **Grow and Develop the Umpire Pool:** Expand the number of League-standard umpires and support their progression toward the C Award minimum through structured education, mentoring, and club-level engagement.
- 3. **Strengthen Umpire Development Pathways:** Establish consistent umpire development programs within all League clubs, supported by accessible online learning resources and practical mentoring opportunities at tournaments, friendlies, and League matches.

Coaching

- 1. Organise and run a Mentorship program
- 2. Continue to market and drive online courses.
- 3. Plan and run a coaching workshop with Twinfit

Responsibility: Anna & Carli

Youth Development

- 1. Contact schools to see what they have planned for the year. Support creating links and supporting the running of fixtures.
- 2. Create links and possibly support fixtures between the schools. Long term plan.
- 3. Send out info on how to become a coach to support the youth development. Linking with Europe netball.
- 4. Long term plan develop school curriculum support for netball.

Responsibility: Anna, Delle, Sarah



National & International Growth Pathways (Netball Europe)

- Strengthen netball on a national level: Launch of a national team program in 2026, aiming to unite top players from across the country and lay the foundation for an officially recognised Dutch national team
- 2. Create more opportunities for international play

- 1. Strengthen netball on an international level: Represent Netherlands in recurring Netball Europe calls
- 2. Strengthen bonds between NL clubs and those in other parts of Europe
- 3. Leverage resources from Netball Europe including Umpiring, Coaching, courses etc.
